La Pelicula de Ana

Ana is an unlucky actress whose economic problems push her towards prostitution. When she agrees to participate in a pseudo-documentary by exploitative, foreign film makers, they get a lot more than they bargained for.



Conducta

Brilliant performances and beautiful camera work combine to make this unembellished look into contemporary Cuba. Capturing the imagination of Havana's film goers, this is the most universally successful Cuban film since 'Strawberry and Chocolate'.



Me Dicen Cuba

The story of how some of Cuba's greatest musicians came together, to record the title song of this moving documentary, in support of the imprisoned Cuban 5 (now happily released as part of the softening of relations between US and Cuba).
